PROM PROGRAM

Full scholarship for short-term study visits of PhD candidates and young academic staff

Are you a PhD candidate or a young academic teacher? Do you want to improve your competencies? Would you like to visit Poland, a thriving European economy, strong academic centre of Central Europe, and one of the most beautiful countries in Europe? Apply now and get a scholarship for a short-term study visit, financed by the Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange.

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

The aim of the PROM program is to increase the internationalization of research by offering a financial support for short-term study visits in Poland. The program is addressed to **PhD candidates, doctoral students and young academic staff**, who want to acquire materials for a doctoral thesis or a research papers or teach at the University in Warsaw.

Following activities may be covered by the programme and will be eligible for a scholarship:

✓ teaching at the University of Warsaw;

☑ participation in short education forms, i.e. in courses, workshops, study visits at the University of Warsaw;

✓ carrying out archive/library queries;

☑ participation in preparation of an international grant application;

☑ other short education forms facilitating increasing competences of a project participant

The study visit can last **7, 14, 21 or 30 days**, including 2 days for travel. **The visit must be carried out before 31 March 2023.**

SCHOLARSHIP

Each participant will receive a scholarship to cover the cost of living and travel fees.

Travel scholarship (a lump sum that depends on the distance from your city to Warsaw):

distance under 500 km - 1 000,00 PLN

distance between 500 and 999 km - 2 000,00 PLN

distance between 1 000 and 2 999 km - **3 000,00 PLN**

distance between 3 000 and 6 000 km- 4 000,00 PLN

distance over 6 000 km - 5 000,00 PLN

Cost of living scholarship:

7 days stay - 4 840,00 PLN

14 days stay - 7 780,00 PLN

21 days stay - 9 700,00 PLN

30 days stay - **12 000,00 PLN**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must:

☑ be a Phd candidate or a young academic (under 40 y. o.)

✓ be enrolled in a doctoral programme or be an academic teacher,

I have an outstanding academic record,

have a strong development potential in his/her career,

demonstrate English language proficiency (min. level B2).

Recruitment procedures are carried out in accordance with the principle of equality and non-discrimination. In particular applicants will not be discriminated against because of disabilities. All applications will be evaluated regardless of age, disability, race, nationality, political beliefs, trade union affiliation, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation or any other personal characteristic protected by the law.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Prepare following documents in English:

a personal questionnaire;

☑ a brief research plan (can be prepared using bullet points);

✓ a short curriculum vitae (max. 1 page);

▼ TOEFL, IELTS or other test report to prove English language proficiency;

recommendation letters from professors (optional).

3. Wait for official confirmation and plan the details of your stay.
